



Howell Mountain Vineyards HMV 2000 Cabernet Sauvignon

Howell Mountain Vineyards is excited to announce the addition of a new Cabernet Sauvignon to their portfolio. The wine is a blend of Cabernets from the two estate vineyards – Beatty Ranch and Black Sears Vineyard both in the Howell Mountain Appellation (57%), and Cabernet from the Napa Valley Appellation (43%).

The nose shows blackberry, black cherry, mahogany and a touch of juniper berry. With vibrant acidity and good length, the wine is soft and appealing – approachable with a touch of austerity.

The layout of the label is similar to the estate Cabernet Sauvignon, but since it is not exclusively from the vineyards in the Howell Mountain Appellation, this wine has been given the moniker of HMV, with a look on the label that gives a nod towards the heraldic California black bear and mountain lion that frequent the property.
